

2025 Leadership Scholarship Application

The **AAOHN Foundation** was established in 1997 to advance the health, safety and well-being of workers, worker populations, and communities through the development of innovative research, education, training solutions, and leadership development. One way in which this purpose is accomplished is by advancing knowledge in occupational and environmental health through the awarding of grants and scholarships to occupational and environmental health professionals to support ongoing education and research.

Scholarship Eligibility: Current AAOHN Foundation Board of Trustees, AAOHN Board of Directors and their relatives are not eligible for Scholarships.

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AAOHN FOUNDATION MEDITRAX LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP Conference of Leaders

Purpose - Award to a licensed occupational and environmental health nurse dedicated to developing leadership skills to better provide for the health and safety of workers in the workplace and protect and ensure the longevity of the occupational health nursing profession.

Funds Awarded: \$1000 for AAOHN Conference of Leaders

Funds are to be applied to offset costs in attending the <u>2025 AAOHN Conference of Leaders</u> (to be used toward registration, travel and lodging expenses). The leadership conference will take place as a Pre-Conference workshop at the <u>2025 National AAOHN Conference</u> in Pittsburgh on Saturday, March 29 and Sunday, March 30. The Conference of Leaders assists in the development of leadership skills for better worker health outcomes. (Additional costs to attend the National Conference are **NOT** included).

Eligibility Criteria – Candidates must be a licensed nurse actively working in the field of occupational and environmental health nursing. Minimum one-year AAOHN national membership is required.

Selection Criteria – Two letters of endorsement must accompany the candidate application: one letter from a nurse colleague and one letter from direct supervisor/manager. Each letter should not exceed one (1) page. Submit a narrative, which addresses each of the criteria listed below. Narrative responses should not exceed four (4) 8½ x 11" pages (typewritten, double-spaced, single-sided with 1" margins using 12-point font). For all acronyms, provide the full name of organization or program upon first use.

Submissions will be judged based on a 100-point system. Each section indicates the maximum number of points the candidate can earn based upon the content submitted. The following factors will be considered in the selection process:

Reports may be published on www.aaohn.org and may be used in other AAOHN publication(s). **Reports are due by May 1**st, **2025.** Scholarship recipients are not eligible to apply for a scholarship the following year but may reapply in subsequent years, up to a maximum of two additional years (three years total).

LIBERTY LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP

Purpose - To award a licensed occupational and environmental health nurse dedicated to developing leadership skills to better provide for the health and safety of workers in the workplace and protect and ensure the longevity of the occupational health nursing profession. his scholarship is funded by AAOHN Fellows and Members in honor and memory of the nurses who lost their lives as a result of the September 11, 2001 event.

Funds Awarded: \$1,500 — one award

Funds are to be applied to leadership education activity/program registration, travel, and/or associated subsistence (food and lodging) fees relating to participation in the program. Note: The recipient may choose the leadership education program; however, the program must be approved by the review panel. Submit an activity/program brochure or other published material along with application.

Eligibility Criteria – Candidates must be a licensed nurse actively working in the field of occupational and environmental health nursing and demonstrate an interest in, and commitment to, occupational and environmental health. Minimum one-year AAOHN national membership is required.

Selection Criteria – Two letters of endorsement must accompany the candidate application: one letter from a nurse colleague and one letter from direct supervisor/manager. Each letter should not exceed one (1) page. Submit a narrative, which addresses each of the criteria listed below. Narrative responses should not exceed four (4) 8½ x 11" pages (typewritten, double-spaced, single-sided with 1" margins using 12-point font). For all acronyms, provide the full name of organization or program upon first use.

Submissions will be judged based on a 100-point system. Each section indicates the maximum number of points the candidate can earn based upon the content submitted. The following factors will be considered in the selection process:

- 35 points Applicant's view of important future challenges for nurse leaders and how the selected professional development activity will assist in meeting these challenges.
- 25 points Describe future professional goals and evidence of commitment to the field of occupational and environmental health nursing.
- 25 points Evidence of commitment to professional leadership development.
- 15 points Demonstration of leadership roles within AAOHN/other professional organizations/community service and how new skills will enhance leadership abilities.

At the end of the leadership education activity, the recipient must submit a copy of the certificate of completion reflecting completion of educational course(s). Also required is a short report, 500 words or less, that shares an example of how knowledge learned through the educational programs attended resulted in a positive impact on worker health and safety. Reports will be published on the website www.aaohn.org and may be used in other AAOHN publication(s). **Reports are due by May 1st, 2025.** Scholarship recipients are not eligible to apply for a scholarship the following year but may reapply in subsequent years, up to a maximum of two additional years (three years total).

GRACE KONDAN FORTUNA LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP AAOHN Conference of Leaders

Funds Awarded: \$700 — one award for AAOHN Conference of Leaders

Funds Awarded: \$1,000 — for 2025 AAOHN National Conference

Funds are to be applied to costs to attend the <u>2025 AAOHN National Conference</u> for the purpose of assisting in the development of leadership skills for better worker health outcomes. Sample costs: registration, travel, and/or associated subsistence (food and lodging) fees relating to participation at conference.

Eligibility Criteria – Candidates must be a licensed nurse actively working in the field of occupational and environmental health nursing. Minimum one-year AAOHN national membership is required.

Selection Criteria – Two letters of endorsement must accompany the candidate application: one letter from a nurse colleague and one letter from direct supervisor/manager. Each letter should not exceed one (1) page.

Submit a narrative, which addresses each of the criteria listed below. Narrative responses should not exceed four (4) 8½ x 11" pages (typewritten, double-spaced, single-sided with 1" margins using 12 point font). For all acronyms, provide full name of organization or program upon first use.

15 points	Commitment: Demonstrate commitment to ongoing continuing education activities.
10 points	Letters of support: Submit letter of support from employer/supervisor and a nurse colleague.
